## PE

## Reading

Reading is still a vital skill and I would encourage children to read as much as possible at home. We are continuing to use Seesaw to record home reading. This can be done through videoing a child read, sending a picture of the book or page number, writing a note to say reading has taken place; no comments are needed. In Y6, I would expect the children to be able to do this themselves. It is important children have a good understanding of what they are reading, so please question your child using the prompts I have given you. Reading books can be changed whenever your child is ready.



## Spellings

A spelling rule is taught every Monday and the children are given 10 words on a Friday to learn throughout the following week. Spellings will be sent out on Ed Shed, with a number of online games for children to complete to help them to learn them. Spelling lessons will take place three times a week with the final lesson including a spelling test on a Friday.
